सर्वप्रथम, माननीय सभापति महोदय द्वारा सभा की बैठक की कार्यवाही प्रारम्भ किए जाने से पूर्व सभा में उपलब्ध सदस्यों के कोरम की पुष्टि हेतु श्री आशुतोष कुमार द्विवेदी, कुलसचिव से सत्यापित कराया। तत्पश्चात् माननीय सभापति महोदय द्वारा सभा के सभी

सदस्यों का स्वागत किया गया एवं वार्षिक अधिवेशन में प्रतिभाग किए जाने के लिए सभी सदस्यों का आभार व्यक्त किया।

उक्त के पश्चात् बिन्दुवार एजेंडा पर निम्नवत विचार-विमर्श/निर्णय लिया गया:—

1. सभापति महोदय द्वारा इस चिकित्सा विश्वविद्यालय में रोगी उपचार सेवाओं को सुदृण करने हेतु विभिन्न कार्य किये गए के सम्बन्ध में निम्नवत अवगत कराया—

“ We are nearly 115 years old, and today this University has acquired national and global immense for its contribution in academics, research and patient care.

The first batch of MBBS students entered the portals of the erstwhile King George's Medical College in October 1911 with 31 students. Since then, KGMU has produced over 30,000 alumni who are the pride of this College and are serving the medical profession in India and all over the world.

We are the now the largest residential University in India with 50 buildings and more than 55 teaching departments in 4 faculties (Medical, Dental, Paramedical & Nursing). Our annual intake is 250 medical & 70 Dental undergraduates, 100 nursing undergraduates, 445 paramedical students, more than 300 medical postgraduates and over 40 super specialty trainees. Besides this the university departments is running MPhil and PhD programs as well. There are almost over 400 faculty, 750 resident doctors, and 5000 employees in the university at any given time.

The Gandhi Memorial and Associated hospitals have over 4000 functional beds with equal number patients admitted (on-bed) at any given time, and has been receiving a footfall of approx 9000-10000 new patients attending the OPD daily in the pre Covid time. We have restarted all OPDs in a controlled fashion ensuring the COVID-19 pandemic safeguards.

A major achievement for the Institute came through the announcement of all India rankings by Ministry of Human Resource Development via National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) in which KGMU ranked 10th among top medical institutions and 50th among all the participating universities and institutions in the country. But more recently, the University has been



adjudged 6th best for Medical and 2nd best for Dental Education by both India today and Outlook Week Magazine during the year 2020. The credit for this success goes entirely to the faculty members, students, research scholars of Medicine, Dental sciences, Nursing and Paramedical school as we continue to do capacity building of infrastructure and human resource of this university besides addressing patient care and improving the ecosystem for medical research.

THE YEAR GONE BY will stand out in the history of this university as we collectively rose to fight the COVID-19 pandemic in the year 2020 and also maintained excellence in field of patient care, research and online education. All management strategies and SOPs were formulated combining International guidelines, ICMR directives and instructions received from Government of India and Government of Uttar Pradesh form time to time.

'**Corona Fever Clinic**' was established for 24 hour services for the patients for effective screening for COVID-19 suspected patients. During period of lockdown, KGMU started '**Digital OPD Services**' for the benefit of the patients. Each department was allocated a unique telephone number for this purpose. More than 39,000 patients received treatment though the e-platform.

'**Corona Control Room**' was established to provide 24 hour advice to the general public regarding COVID-19 related information and activities. CCR has seamlessly synergised with the district administration nodal officers and Integrated Command centre for all type of data collection and records.

#### **COVID testing**

- COVID testing in UP and Uttrakhand started with KGMU.
- Today we have FIVE (5) real times PCR, and Two (2) TruNat testing machines, currently working 24x7, wherein **6000 tests are performed daily as of today.**
- The Dept of microbiology has single handedly conducted more than 10 lacs tests since the inception of the pandemic which is the highest no any centre in the country has achieved.

- KGMU was nominated as **'Mentor Institute'** by ICMR to guide 44 healthcare facilities in increasing COVID-19 testing capacity and for External quality assurance in Uttar Pradesh.
- We were the first to start sample pooling for COVID-19 testing in the State.
- ICMR has also nominated KGMU as **'Centre for excellence'** for RTPCR kits, VTM, and Extraction kits and has been declared as **regional 'depot'** for ensuring transparent procurement of high quality COVID testing kits through GeM portal and ensuring their smooth distribution in 15 healthcare institutes in Uttar Pradesh.

### **Setting up COVID Hospital**

Under the directions of the State Govt, KGMU Started a dedicated COVID hospital in RALC building of 500 beds capacity overall, with 250 beds for Intensive Critical Care. Shri Suresh Khanna ji has been the chief architect in conceptualizing and planning for augmentation of ICU beds in the Covid hospital. He meticulously set targets timelines and must do lists for us which we accomplished with aplomb. A 20,000 litres capacity of Liquid oxygen tank was installed in record time. In addition to all this, I am proud to inform you all that trauma and emergency services continued uninterruptedly throughout the pandemic period for the benefit of patient care.

### **Research in COVID**

KGMU in collaboration with Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University, Lucknow presented to the State Government an Artificial Intelligence based model from X ray images of COVID-19 patients for early and accurate screening of the disease. There are approximately 74 research activities related to COVID-19 currently under execution in King George's Medical University by various faculty members that have been approved by the Institutional Ethics Committee.

### **Public Awareness – COVID**

A mobile/web based application **'Chikitsa Setu'** was developed by us in collaboration with National Institute of Smart Governance, which was inaugurated by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh, Shri Adityanath Yogi ji on 19<sup>th</sup> May 2020. Information related to COVID-19 was also disseminated

through social media platforms and various online platforms like zoom, youtube, facebook etc.

### **COVID care – Plasma Therapy**

KGMU was the first in the State of Uttar Pradesh to **start ‘Plasma therapy’** for COVID 19 patients. **First plasma bank of the State** was inaugurated by Hon’ble Governor of Uttar Pradesh, Smt. Anandiben Patel at KGMU on this year Independence day, 15<sup>th</sup> August 2020. KGMU through Department of Transfusion medicine is the knowledge partner and established plasma therapy all over the state. A total of 400 patients have donated plasma and 520 COVID patients have so far been benefitted from plasma therapy at our Covid Hospital.

### **Continuing Non Covid care**

- Shifting academics to virtual platform with Online classes for all medical, dental, nursing and paramedical students was done meticulously in the backdrop of the pandemic. This was a learning exercise and required great IT skills, and innovations for meaningful dialogues, interactions and for the faculty to reach out to all students even at the peak of the pandemic.
- I would like to especially mention a few depts who continued NON COVID care all along including Medicine, Surgery, Trauma Sx, Ortho, Emerg med, Paed, O&G, Surg Onco and Radiotherapy, Micro, Radiology, Path, & Biochemistry. A special mention to Medical ICU, Anaesthesia, TVU, CCM & PCCM for rendering exemplary critical care.

### **New Courses**

- DM in Pulmonary Medicine for 2 seats has been approved from this academic year
- Renewal and recognition for 6 seats in MD Microbiology and 2 seats in M.Ch Endocrine surgery from this academic year.
- First time in India KGMU Faculty of Paramedical sciences has started Continuing Para Medical Education Program.

### **New Additions Infrastructure**

- Free health camps were organised by the social outreach cell of KGMU till Mar this year and more than 5695 patients got free medical aid in these camps.
- Dept of Biotechnology approved a joint venture in June 2020 with IIT Kanpur and KGMU would be called 'School of International Biodesign- Synergising Healthcare Innovation and Entrepreneurship'. The school plans to train around 50 biomedical engineers in the next 5 yrs, and to develop at least 35 to 40 global standard products related to medical Technology innovations over this period.
- 6<sup>th</sup> International Yoga day was celebrated on the 21<sup>st</sup> Jun with a theme of Yoga to fight Covid 19
- The Medical Education Dept celebrated the the 3<sup>rd</sup> Dr APJ Kalam Memorial Celebration on the 16<sup>th</sup> Oct in which Padamshri Prof Krishnaswamy Vijay Raghavan, FRS< PSA to GOI delivered a lec on Medical Research & Edu during and after the pandemic
- KGMU library is one of the best in the country and has recently gained free trial access to various platforms like CBME (Wolters Kluwer), MedOne Education, Eduport, and Ovid platforms
- IT cell enhanced its infrastructure by leaps and bounds with LAN and Wifi to over 5000 computers, improved e-hospital patient management system with integrated CCTV monitoring facility.
- Multidisciplinary research unit, KGMU funded by Health research upgraded the 3D printing and surgical planning facility with a Mimics Innovation suit software for designing of surgical guides and implants.
- KGMU is the only centre in UP conducting ATLS Provider courses, ATLS Instructor courses for doctors, ATCN provider courses for nurses, besides conducting BLS courses for students and health professionals, Palliative skill courses, BMW management courses and soft skill course.
- Over 7.2 lac patients were seen in the OPD and over 14000 surgeries were performed in the last year despite the Covid pandemic.
- The First Human milk bank has continued to grow and 128 babies received donor human milk.
- Dept of Obs. & Gyane. conducted 336 LSCS/ vaginal deliveries in Covid +cases since the initiation of pandemic.

- Energy conserving SOPs have been revitalized, Reusable energy resources like Solar panels have been made operational during the last 6 months and we are generating 1600 units of clean electricity daily. We plan to extend it to 3500 units in next one month. Our energy saving drive has resulted in decreasing our electricity bill, substantially over the last 2 months.

### **Addition of Infrastructure**

- A number of significant projects were inaugurated in KGMU on 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2020 with support of Government of Uttar Pradesh by Hon'ble Minister of Medical Education, Uttar Pradesh. Under the scheme of National Health Mission, a 100 bedded, block 'A' in MCH wing was inaugurated in Queen Mary Hospital; Medical gas plants and pipeline in 13 clinical departments of KGMU; Construction work for Faculty/Employee residence in Amrapali Yojna, Hardoi road; Construction of 'Foot over-bridge' to Queen Mary Hospital; Establishment of Fire alarms and Hydrants.
- Recently a state of art – Centre for **Orthopaedics Super-specialities** was also inaugurated by the Hble Minister of Medical Education, wherein 04 super-speciality depts. including Paediatric orthopaedics, Sports medicine, Orthoplasty and Spine surgery will function under one roof. I am told this is the country's first Orthopaedic super-speciality centre.
- Also largest Burn Care Facility with 35 ICU beds, 4 modular operation theatres, a skin bank, hyperbaric oxygen and dialysis facility in Uttar Pradesh was inaugurated on 05<sup>th</sup> January 2021. I am sure that this facility will be a boon for the patients of this region and it will prove to be a unique teaching, training and research centre for the whole of UP in particular and the country in general.
- With the inauguration of premises allocated for operations of **newly developed Community Radio Station** FM 89.6 in Shatabadi Hospital phase-2, it is for the first time that such an initiative has been taken by any healthcare university wherein KGMU will connect with the community on health advisories and initiatives.

### **Promotion & Fresh Recruitments of Faculty members**

- The process of promotions of faculty and as well fresh recruitment in various disciplines in ongoing. As of date, there has been as many as 27 faculty

members have been promoted already and we have selected 43 more faculty members in the various disciplines of the University

इसके अतिरिक्त यह भी अवगत कराया गया कि नवनिर्मित गठित राष्ट्रीय अर्युर्विज्ञान आयोग के मेडिकल एडवाइजर काउन्सिल में किंग जार्ज चिकित्सा विश्वविद्यालय के

माननीय कुलपति ले०जनरल (डा०) बिपिन पुरी जी, पदेन सदस्य के रूप में मनोनीत हैं।

6. दन्त चिकित्सक अधिनियम, 1948 की धारा 3 (घ) के अंतर्गत भारतीय दन्त परिषद में एक सदस्य हेतु एक प्रतिनिधि के निर्वाचन के सम्बन्ध में विश्वविद्यालय के कुलसचिव/निर्वाचन अधिकारी द्वारा अवगत कराया गया कि उक्त चुनाव में दन्त संकाय के दो प्रत्याशियों (डा० अनिल चंद्रा एवं डा० पवित्र कुमार रस्तोगी) द्वारा उम्मीदवारी प्रस्तुत की गयी है। पूर्व निर्धारित कार्यक्रम के अंतर्गत बैलेट पेपर से मतदान कार्यक्रम में कुल 87 मतदाताओं में से 72 मतदाताओं ने अपने मताधिकार का प्रयोग किया। जिसके पश्चात मतगणना में यह पाया गया कि डा० अनिल चंद्रा के पक्ष में 46 मत, डा० पवित्र कुमार रस्तोगी के पक्ष में 25 मत पड़े हैं। इसके अतिरिक्त 01 मत अमान्य पाया गया। अतः कुलसचिव/निर्वाचन अधिकारी द्वारा सर्वाधिक वोट पाने वाले प्रत्याशी, डा० अनिल चंद्रा, अधिष्ठाता दन्त संकाय एवं आचार्य, कंसरवेटिव डेंटिसट्री एण्ड इन्डोडानटिक्स विभाग को विजयी प्रत्याशी घोषित किया तथा विजयी होने का सर्टिफिकेट जारी किया।

उक्त निर्वाचन कार्यक्रम के पश्चात दोनों प्रत्याशियों द्वारा कुशल/पारदर्शी तरीके से निर्वाचन कार्यक्रम आयोजित किये जाने हेतु कुलसचिव/ निर्वाचन अधिकारी का धन्यवाद किया।

7. विश्वविद्यालय के अधिनियम की धारा 24 (1) के अंतर्गत चार सदस्यों का कार्य परिषद हेतु निर्वाचन के सम्बन्ध में विश्वविद्यालय के कुलसचिव द्वारा अवगत कराया गया कि उक्त हेतु सर्वप्रथम, माननीय कुलपति जी के अनुमोदनोपरांत चिकित्सा विश्वविद्यालय की नोटिस संख्या 302/मीटिंग सेल दिनांक 09.12.2020 द्वारा किंग जार्ज चिकित्सा विश्वविद्यालय अधिनियम, 2002 की धारा 26(1)(नौ) के अन्तर्गत 15 रजिस्टर्ड ग्रेजुएट्स का विश्वविद्यालय की सभा में सदस्यता/प्रतिनिधित्व हेतु निर्वाचन कार्यक्रम प्रस्तावित किया गया था।

इसी मध्य विश्वविद्यालय की रजिस्टर्ड ग्रेजुएट की सूची में कतिपय अशुद्धियों कुल 15, जिनके द्वारा के0जी0एम0यू0, पूर्ववर्ती के0जी0डी0यू0 अथवा नियत दिनांक से पूर्व के0जी0एम0सी0 से स्नातक उपाधि नहीं प्राप्त की गई है, के सम्बन्ध में डा0 नईम अहमद, प्रोफेसर, कम्यूनिटी मेडिसिन एवं पब्लिक हेल्थ विभाग, के0जी0एम0यू0 के प्रत्यावेदन दिनांक 05.12.2020 (जोकि कुलसचिव कार्यालय, के0जी0एम0यू0 में दिनांक 09.12.2020 को प्राप्त हुआ) को विश्वविद्यालय के कुलसचिव को प्रेषित किया गया तथा उसी आधार पर स्वयं का नाम (डा0 नईम अहमद) विश्वविद्यालय की रजिस्टर्ड ग्रेजुएट सूची में सम्मिलित करने हेतु निवेदन किया गया।

उक्त के आलोक में यह स्थिति स्पष्ट है कि वर्तमान निर्धारित नामांकन कार्यक्रम हेतु निर्धारित मतदाता सूची में कतिपय अशुद्धियाँ विद्यमान है जिसकी जानकारी/सूचना डा0 नईम अहमद के प्रत्यावेदन दिनांक 05.12.2020 से विश्वविद्यालय को प्राप्त हुई है। उक्त अशुद्ध मतदाता सूची में चिन्हित किसी अशुद्ध प्रविष्टि द्वारा नामांकन करने अथवा मत का प्रयोग करने से मतदान के निर्णय पर तो असर पड़ेगा ही अपितु पूरे नामांकन कार्यक्रम की प्रक्रिया पर सवाल उत्पन्न हो सकता है तथा भविष्य में विधिक/क्रानूनी अड़चने भी उत्पन्न हो सकती हैं। इस सम्बन्ध में उक्त पर विश्वविद्यालय के विधिक अधिवक्ता से प्राप्त अभिमत के क्रम में रजिस्टर्ड ग्रेजुएट की प्रकाशित सूची का पुनः परीक्षण करते हुए संशोधित सूची का प्रकाशन किया जाना आवश्यक पाया गया।


उक्त के आलोक में मा0 कुलपति जी के अनुमोदनोपरान्त, विश्वविद्यालय की रजिस्टर्ड ग्रेजुएट की सूची में व्याप्त कतिपय अशुद्धियों के निस्तारण के सम्बन्ध में नियमानुसार उचित कार्यवाही करने के उपरान्त, रजिस्टर्ड ग्रेजुएट की संशोधित सूची प्रकाशित करते हुए, तत्पश्चात् निर्वाचन कार्यक्रम संपन्न कराये जाने का निर्णय लिया गया है। अतः चिकित्सा विश्वविद्यालय की नोटिस संख्या 302/मीटिंग सेल दिनांक 09.12.2020 द्वारा निर्धारित किंग जार्ज चिकित्सा विश्वविद्यालय अधिनियम, 2002 की धारा 26(1)(नौ) के अन्तर्गत 15 रजिस्टर्ड ग्रेजुएट्स का विश्वविद्यालय की सभा में सदस्यता/प्रतिनिधित्व हेतु निर्वाचन कार्यक्रम विश्वविद्यालय के कार्यालय ज्ञाप संख्या 326/मीटिंग सेल दिनांक 24.12.2020 द्वारा निरस्त कर दिया गया।



अतः विश्वविद्यालय के अधिनियम की धारा 24 (1) के अंतर्गत चार सदस्यों का कार्य परिषद हेतु निर्वाचन कार्यक्रम स्थगित किया गया।
