Institutional Distinctiveness

King George's Medical University is distinctive and stands apart amongst all the contemporary institutes and Universities with its immense research contributions to the literature and the society.

The research has identified a total of approximately 10,000 Journal and Conference Publications by authors affiliated to King George's Medical University from the year period 1911 to 2020, from five main research databases-Web of Science, Scopus, Pubmed, Google scholar and Indian Citation Index.

There is an average range of 3000-4000 citations of this published research every year.

The range of impact factors of contributing journals is 0.018 to 55.873

Average consolidated impact factor of contributing journals is 2.55

The h index of the University according to Scopus database was calculated as 65 in 2017. This values is currently-39

Besides research publications, the faculty of King George's Medical University is constantly contributing to extramural research. There are approximately 200-250 extramural projects running at any point of time. These research proposals are being supported by various reputed funding agencies of Government and also International support. Approximately 300-350 proposals are being submitted annually to these funding agencies. That indicates a relatively good proportion of conversion to funding in absolute percentage.
