The establishment of the Trauma Centre at King George's Medical University, Lucknow, more than two decades ago marked the inception of one of the country's first trauma centres.

On January 4th 2017, the distinguished Department of Trauma Surgery was inaugurated, representing a significant milestone for King George's Medical University. This historic event underscored the university's commitment to providing exceptional holistic care for trauma victims, revolutionizing trauma care in Uttar Pradesh and across the country.

Initiating the "MS (Traumatology and Surgery)" course in 2022 solidified our position as pioneers in trauma care, adding the impetus to Teaching, Training, and research avenues in addition to patient care. We became the first Government institute in India to offer such a program.

We are the only government-approved Level I trauma centre functioning in the state of Uttar Pradesh and are the crucial destination for critically injured trauma patients in this region.

Our department delivers a comprehensive array of acute trauma care services, including assessment, resuscitation, damage control strategies, definitive surgeries, trauma critical care, and patient rehabilitation in collaboration with a team of multidisciplinary experts.
